



## SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES FOR DOCTORS APPOINTED IN THE OFFICIAL UWW COMPETITIONS

As a UWW Doctor appointed in a UWW competition, your duties are:

### Organization & competition

- To supervise the organization of the medical examination before the weigh-ins.
- After the medical examination, to provide the UWW competition Secretariat with the list of participants, dully signed.
- To supervise and follow-up the first aid to wrestlers with the help of local doctors and medical auxiliaries.
- To attend the **Referees meeting** and the **Technical Conference** to present all medical aspects to the Referees and Teams.
- To convene a **pre-competition meeting** with the local medical team to ensure that all doctors and paramedics are familiarized with wrestling competitions, typical wrestling injuries and make sure they have the necessary qualifications.
- To verify that the equipment of the first aid room is complete and appropriate
- To decide whether an injured wrestler may resume or stop the bout, in accordance with the International Wrestling Rules
- To verify that the meals offered to the participants are appropriate and that they comply with the quantity of calories required in the UWW Medical Regulations.
- To verify that the conditions of accommodation of the participants are appropriate.

### Anti-doping

- To collaborate with the National Anti-Doping Organisation/Service Provider for all doping tests as requested by UWW in the *Test Distribution Plan*<sup>1</sup>, in particular:
  - to ensure that conditions are in place to allow a time efficient testing procedure;
  - to ensure that a space in the competition venue is used as a Doping Control Station (DCS) where **privacy, sole use** and **cleanliness** are guaranteed. This room will be used only as DCS and its access will be restricted.  
  
If the room does not offer the Athlete privacy, and/or is intended to be used for purposes other than Doping Control while Sample collection is being carried out, you have the obligation to locate an alternative room/location to ensure that privacy and sole use are guaranteed.
  - to coordinate with the Doping Control Officers (DCFs) for the timing and selection of wrestlers.
  - to make sure that chaperones are available to accompany the selected wrestlers to the doping control room(s) and are well trained.
  - To make sure that the Doping Control Officers are informed of the possibility of **Minors** being tested during the competition and to ensure that minors are notified for testing in the presence of an adult.

<sup>1</sup> The Test Distribution Plan (TDP) is forwarded by UWW directly to the Sample Collection Authority (SCA). It may not be modified unless exceptional circumstances.



## Injuries & reporting

- To submit all injuries in ATHENA using your username & password.

Note: you will find attached the injury report paper form. You may choose to use the paper form during the competition and submit the injuries in the system afterwards or submit the injuries directly in the system during the competition.

- To fill in the “Hospital Transfer Form” attached. You are kindly requested to fill in this form in case a wrestler must be transported to hospital. This form must be handed over to the wrestler before he/she is transported to hospital. The wrestler (or the Federation) shall send it to the United World Wrestling insurance company with the accident declaration form (IMSSA).

## Procedure for Insurance

All athletes, referees and coaches holding a valid license are insured by IMSSA Insurance for any accident or illness occurring during a trip abroad for a competition on the UWW calendar.

## Procedure for the Injured person:

In case of an accident or illness, the insured person or his/her National Federation must:

- Immediately inform UWW of the accident and send a copy of the passport to [info@unitedworldwrestling.org](mailto:info@unitedworldwrestling.org)
- Fill in an online insurance claim on IMSSA website within 48 hours as follows:
  1. Log in on IMSSA website <https://www.imssa-sos.com/en>
  2. Username: UWW
  3. Password: 22AYCA094011
  4. Follow the instructions.

## **→ Your role as Official Doctor:**

A Medical Certificate signed by the Doctor of the competition (if one has been appointed), or from the Doctor who examined the patient, must be uploaded on IMSSA Website by the injured person.

**Without the Medical Certificate and the online declaration, IMSSA will not consider the claim.**
